#### *Project Description:*

A tessellation is created when a shape is repeated over and over again covering a plane without any gaps or overlaps. Using Foundations and Stroke & Coats make this easy to do.

*Instructions:* Project instructions below. Mayco encourages you to vary colors, patterns and techniques to create your own designs.

---

1. Begin with properly fired shelf cone 04 [Bisque](#). Moisten a clean [Sponge](#) and wipe [Bisque](#) to remove any dust.
  2. Using a CB-604 # 4 Soft Fan, apply 2 [Coats](#) of FN-001 White to the tile.
  3. Fold paper on lines and cut out design following the pattern.
  4. Hold paper in position on the tile, brush water under the paper then lay in the paper on the wet [Glaze](#) brush more water on top of the paper. Press with a paper towel to remove excess water. This will help prevent the paper from ripping.
  5. Using a CB-604 # 4 Soft Fan, apply 1 coat of FN-001 White over the pattern to adhere it to the tile and keep any contrasting color from coming through.
  6. Using a CB-604 # 4 Soft Fan, apply 2 [Coats](#) of SC-74 Hot Tamale over the entire tile. When the [Glaze](#) loses its shine then pull off the pattern.
  7. Using a CB-110 # 10/0 Liner, add eye to fish using SC-15 Tuxedo. Allow to dry.
  8. Stilt and fire to shelf cone 06.
